

Enhanced Rural Recycling

Drop off points for your recycling is available at Kekerengu, Clarence, Suburban School or Lynton Downs.

Make sure:

- Your items are secure so your recycling does not get blown by wind. Make sure you replace the lid.
- All items dropped off are recyclable



What do I do with rubbish?

There is no rubbish collection in Kaikoura—if your waste can't be recycled, drop it into the Innovative Waste Kaikoura (IWK), Scarborough Street. A charge will apply.

What can I drop off at the Rural Recycling Point?

Plastic—all hard and soft plastic. Clean plastic bags, cling wrap, etc

Paper and card—all cardboard, mixed paper, newspapers, letters, envelopes, junkmail

Metal-cans, tins, aluminium and steel

Make sure these items are bundled and tied with string or bagged securely

Glass—all glass should be separated from other recycling

Please rinse all items

Other items can be taken up to IWK for recycling, no charge if clean and re-usable:

Light bulbs, clothing, household items, toys, sports gear, curtains, bedding, furniture, old office equipment. All metal

TV's and Computer monitors attract a charge

Recyclable items, where there may be a small charge:

Electronic items, old appliances, cars, mobile phones

Batteries, oil, printer cartridges

Disposable Nappies, Sanitary items—buy disposal bags from IWK or Council

Tips to help you recycle

And save money

Make sure:

- Your items are secure so your recycling does not get blown by wind
- All items put in the bin at Suburban School are recyclable
- Your recycling is not contaminated with food waste
- No Glass is mixed with other recyclable product
- There are non-recyclable items in your bags or bins
- Food waste can be taken up to IWK for composting or you can compost at home



What do I do with rubbish?

What can be put in the bin at Suburban School?
