Family Violence Officer's Report

The Kaikoura Family Violence Network is still working through our Strategic plan, adding a Maori component to the strategy. We were unable to have a meeting last month due to amount of apologies.

Adult and Community Education Funding has been received by the Family Violence Network.

We plan to use this funding towards Training of local facilitators for anger management programmes.

The Kaikoura Family Violence Network, would like to express their appreciation to the Kaikoura High School and Adult and Community Education Department, for the funding.

Reports to Crime Prevention Unit have been forwarded to the Justice Department; we look forward to their feedback with these.

The network has also discussed organising a morning Tea to liaise with other organisations in this field.

Kaikoura St Johns and Marlborough Women's Refuge now have the Family Violence Network reporting forms.

These confidential forms collect data of the family Violence incidents here in Kaikoura.

This will then help us to see if clients have been referred on to relevant agencies, ethnicity and degree of injuries.

The Kaikoura Medical Centre already has this form.

We will meet next week to discuss our display at the Community Expo, who will be available to attend, and possible roster out times for the table.
