5. APPOINTMENT OF DEPUTY MAYOR

The Local Government Act 2002 was amended by the insertion of the new section 41A. This section came into effect from 12 October 2013.

The new provision sets out the role and powers of Mayors. One of those powers is to

- a) appoint the deputy mayor
- b) establish committees of the territorial authority
- c) appoint the chairperson of each committee established under (b) above.

Previously the position of deputy mayor was elected by Council.

It is recommended that Council endorse the Mayors appointment to the position of Deputy Mayor.
