
The Kaikoura District Council Speed Limits Bylaw 2008

1. Introduction

Pursuant to Section 684(1)(13) of the Local Government Act 1974, the Local Government Act 2002 and Land Transport Rule: Setting of Speed Limits 2003 the Kaikoura District Council makes this bylaw to set speed limits as specified in the schedules.

2. Title

The title of this bylaw is the Kaikoura District Council Speed Limits Bylaw 2008.

3. Date the speed limits come into force

The speed limits described in the schedules come into force on the date specified in the schedules.

4. Interpretation:

Road means the same as in Land Transport Rule: Setting of Speed Limits 2003

Speed limit means the same as in Land Transport Rule: Setting of Speed Limits 2003

Urban traffic area means the same as in Land Transport Rule: Setting of Speed Limits 2003

5. Speed limits

The roads or areas described in the schedules specified in paragraph 6 or as shown on a map referenced in the schedules are declared to have the speed limits specified in the schedules and maps, which are part of this bylaw.

6. Schedules

Schedule 1: Urban traffic areas - roads that have a speed limit of 50 km/h.

Schedule 2: Roads that have a speed limit of 70 km/h

Schedule 3: Roads that have a speed limit of 80 km/h

Schedule 4: Rural areas - roads that have a speed limit of 50 km/h.

Schedule 5: Rural areas - roads that have a speed limit of 100 km/h.

7. Date bylaw made

This bylaw was made by the Kaikoura District Council at a meeting of the Council on 16 February 2005. Amended and adopted on 25 July 2008.
