

# MINUTES OF THE KAIKŌURA DISTRICT COUNCIL HEARINGS ON SUBMISSIONS TO THE WASTE MANAGEMENT AND MINIMISATION PLAN ON THURSDAY 11 FEBRUARY 2021, 9.00AM, TOTARA, 96 WEST END, KAIKŌURA

## 3. SUBMITTERS TO BE HEARD THURSDAY 11 FEBRUARY 2021:

### 9.00am - R Hogan – page 2

R Hogan spoke to his submission to the Waste Management and Minimisation Plan (WMMP). He explained the purpose of speaking to his submission was to hopefully convince Council to encourage waste minimisation as he felt the proposed plan was not relative to reducing rubbish. He gave examples from Section 4 of the WMMP, such as ending kerbside collection at Peketa and fortnightly collection from the suburban area, commenting that these recommendations do not promote waste minimisation. R Hogan referenced the Waste Minimisation Act 2008 and questioned whether providing a kerbside refuse pickup service was in accordance with the principles of that act.

R Hogan disagreed with the petition presented to Council in June 2020 that favours waste management to be levied through rates. He would pay approximately \$100 to put his annual one 20kg bag in landfill, should the user-pay option not be approved by Council. R Hogan questioned the current recycling and waste expenditure by Council and had previously asked for data and costs. Further questions will be raised outside this hearing. Copies of R Hogan's verbal submission were provided to those present at the hearing.

## 4. HEARINGS AND DELIBERATION

It was noted that the hearings would continue on 17<sup>th</sup> February 2021 where one submitter has requested to speak to their submission. It was agreed that Council would deliberate on 17<sup>th</sup> February 2021 after reviewing all the submissions.
