## USING OUR APP FOR EBOOKS

Download our app **LIBERTY LINK** from your App or Play Store

### ONE

Under the **SETUP** tab, select **SCAN SETUP CODE** and scan the QR code featured. Enter your Library login details:

**Username:** B00012345 (number off your Library card)

**Password:** kaikoura (unless you have changed this)



### TWO

You can now click into the search bar and start browsing!

If the item you are looking at is an eBook it will give you to option to borrow straight away. Click **BORROW**, then **OPEN**.

You will then be taken to our ebook platform **WHEELERS EPLATFORM**. You will need to sign in again with the same details you use to login to your Library account. You can tick the **Keep me signed in on this device**, so you don't have to login each time.

You will then be taken straight to your book, happy reading! Click the back arrow and using the search bar browse and borrow more books.

Our App doesn't yet have the ability to search our catalogue specifically for eBooks only, however the **WHEELERS EPLATFORM** does! Once you are redirected here in step three, you may want to stay and navigate our catalogue. You can get eBooks out, return them, renew them just like our Library App.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- 1.If your device is not letting you open your book, go into your settings and check your device is not blocking pop ups. If this sounds like jiberish, please ask the Library staff for help.
- 2.Each issue is for three weeks, the same as our Library books.
- 3.Once your three weeks are complete, the item will disappear from your loans.
- 4.If you need longer to finish your book, you can renew your loan through the app like your other books.
