#### 6. WORKS AND SERVICES MONTHLY BUSINESS AS USUAL (BAU) REPORT

S Murphy presented the W&S BAU Report.

The widening of the remaining NCTIR haul roads are scheduled to commence next week starting with Red Swamp Road and Ludstone Road. Wā Kaukau Terrace (new Aquatic Centre road) would be sealed next month.

The LED light roll-out is on track to be completed by mid-November. Positive feedback has been received to date. The new light dimming system was put into action quickly with the recent Hutton Shearwater fallout.

It was noted that maintenance repair work to the look-out car park has been completed. This is proposed to be sealed as part of the linkpathway project.

ECAN have provided feedback on consents required for the Link Pathway. Council staff have engaged an archeologist to undertake a heritage assessment for the project and will engage with the Rūnanga on this.

A request for Fibre Broadband has been received for the service to be installed North of Mill Road along State Highway 1. The Roading Engineer is liaising with the South Island Regional Manager to see if this is possible.

A discussion was held around the temporary filling / patching of potholes that need permanent repairment. S Murphy would follow up with the Roading Contractor.
