Workshop Notes:	<p><u>Purpose of the workshop/short description:</u></p> <p>Overview of NZTA’s procurement strategy as councillor endorsement will be required.</p> <p>In order to get subsidy from NZTA, the Council needs to endorse the procurement strategy to comply with their rules.</p>
	<p><u>What was discussed:</u></p> <p>Discussions held with NZTA and a couple of suggested changes to the last strategy. Tabled the presentation with proposed changes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Encouraging local suppliers – need to have a primary operating business or an operating base within the Kaikoura District. Example used was Downer who employ local people, majority of their team live in the District. Out of town contractors do not contribute to the community. • General comments – procurement issues. NZTA did not like this clause as they feel quality is more important than the approach of lowest price conforming. This clause is not going to change. The Council still need to be satisfied that they can do the job properly and follow H&S practices. • LGA S17A review – these reviews need to be done every 6 years. The previous review still appears very valid. • The Council asked NZTA if they could deliver in-house pothole repairs under a works crew. NZTA advised that councils are not allowed to undertake these repairs as they must be done by a roading contractor.
