Workshop Notes:	<u>Purpose of the workshop/short description:</u> Discussion on a request for additional trading site.
	<u>What was discussed:</u> Enquiry from a person who wants to set up a mobile shop that sells different types of food from those currently trading there. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Currently there are three license to occupy sites and the Council would need to create another site for the food truck. • The requester has discussed their proposal with the seafood BBQ and they are supportive of it. • A fourth mobile shop will take away parking but there is potential for parking further along. Can define parking better once the Link Pathway is complete along there. • All the food sites at Jimmy Armers will be marked out and the operators will need to stick within their sites. • Layout and positioning of the sites need to be changed as they should all face the ocean for health & safety reasons (people cuing on the roadside).
