

PUBLIC NOTICE

ON, OFF, & CLUB LICENCES/RENEWALS SALE AND SUPPLY OF ALCOHOL ACT 2012

Middlehurst Delivered Limited has made application to the Kaikoura District Licensing Committee for the issue of an **On-Licence** in respect of the premises situated at **54 West End, Kaikoura**.

The general nature of the business conducted (or to be conducted) under the licence is:

Restaurant.

The days on which and the hours during which liquor is (or is intended to be) sold under the licence are:

Monday to Sunday 12pm – 11pm.

The application may be inspected during ordinary office hours at the office of the Kaikōura District Licensing Committee, C/- Council Offices, 96 West End, Kaikōura.

Any person who is entitled to object and who wishes to object to the grant of the application may, not later than **25 working days** after the date of the first publication of this notice, file a notice in writing of the objection with the **Secretary of the District Licensing Committee at PO Box 6, Kaikōura**.

No objection to the issue of a licence may be made in relation to a matter other than a matter specified in section 105(1) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

No objection to the renewal of a licence may be made in relation to a matter other than a matter specified in section 131 of the Sale of Supply of alcohol Act 2012.

Important to Note – Public Notification of Application the applicant is responsible to apply to the Council to place this advert on their website, within **10 working days** for renewal of licence or **20 working days** for new licence after filing this application. It is best to file this at the time of application. As well as the Council Website we may require with some new applications or large variations to have 2 advertisements placed in the local newspaper no more than 1 week apart. This requirement will be determined at the time of application.

This notice must run on the website for the required time before your licence can be processed.

The applicant is also required to display an A4 sized (minimum) public notice of the applications, in a conspicuous place on the premises, from the date the notice is put on the website, for a period of 15 days.
